2005 AAU REGION VI CHAMPIONSHIP RELAY DECLARATION FORM

1. Participation of relay teams shall be limited to those clubs that hold current valid membership in the AAU prior to the Association Championship. Relay team members must be of the same age and gender.
2. Relay teams shall consist of four(4) members plus up to four(4) alternate members, for a maximum 8 total from the same club, to be declared at the time of entry into each meet. Once the entry has been forwarded to the National Director, no changes may be made for those names submitted.
3. Clubs must qualify teams in the Association meet to participate at the Regional Championship.
4. All participating team members must wear jerseys(tops) and shorts of the same color.
5. Substitutions in a relay team may be only made from the list of athletes from the same club, declared for that event. The composition of the order of the team and the order of running must be declared before the start of the competition.
6. All participants must have an individual entry form and specify their entry into this event or **THEY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE.**
7. **THROWING THE BATON WILL BE AN AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFICATION**
